THE A1 HOLLOWAY ROAD (FURLONG ROAD / DIGSWELL STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF ISLINGTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

Made 29th January 2021

Coming into force 29th January 2021

Transport for London having consulted London Borough of Islington and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A1 Holloway Road (Furlong Road / Digswell Street, London Borough of Islington) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Stopping) Order 2021 and shall come into force on the 29 January 2021.
2. This Order is made because Transport for London is satisfied that traffic in the London Borough of Islington should be prohibited from making certain movements on A1 Holloway Road because works are being executed.
3. From 12:01 AM on 29th January 2021 until 11:59 PM on 31st July 2021 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to:
 - (1) enter, exit or proceed on Furlong Road at its junction with Holloway Road;
 - (2) stop on the loading and parking bays outside Nos. 47 to 49, 54 to 58, A1 Holloway Road between Outside No.22 to its junction with Fieldway Crescent;
 - (3) enter, exit or proceed on Digswell Street at its junction with Holloway Road;
 - (4) enter or proceed on bus lanes on A1 Holloway Road between outside of No.22 Holloway Road to its junction with Fieldway Crescent.

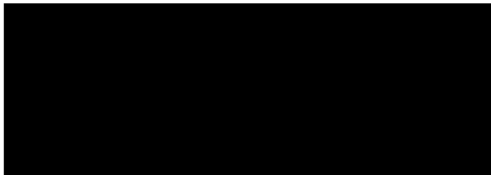

4. (1) The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

(2) The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of:
 - (i) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works;
 - (ii) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle;
 - (iii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs.
