THE A202 GLA ROAD AND THE A200 GLA SIDE ROAD (QUEEN'S ROAD AND SOUTHWARK PARK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGHES OF SOUTHWARK AND LEWISHAM) BANNED TURNS TRAFFIC ORDER 2022

<i>Coming into force</i>	9th April 2022

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The A202 GLA Road and The A200 GLA Side Road (Queen's Road and Southwark Park Road, London Boroughs of Southwark And Lewisham) Banned Turns Traffic Order 2022, and shall come into force on 9th April 2022.

2. Banned Turns

- (1) No person causing or permitting a vehicle, except pedal cycles, buses and taxis, proceeding northwards on the A200 GLA Side Road Southwark Park Road shall cause or permit that vehicle to turn right into the A200 Jamaica Road.
- (2) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding eastwards on the A202 GLA Road Queen's Road shall cause or permit that vehicle to turn left into Lausanne Road.

3. Exemptions


- (1) Nothing in article 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

4. Revocations

- (1) This Order revokes any previous Banned Turn Order(s) or Prescribed Route Order(s) in so far as their provisions relate to the banned turns specified in article 2 above.
