28 February 2011 Coming into force

The Mayor of London keeps under review the roads and proposed roads which have junctions with GLA roads or with other roads having such junctions and he considers it expedient that certain roads in the London Borough of Enfield should become or cease to be GLA Side Roads. Therefore, the Greater London Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 124B(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984a and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of the Council of the London Borough of Enfield, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as The GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Enfield) Designation Variation Order 2011 and shall come into force on 28 February 2011.

2. Variation

From the date on which this Order comes into force, the Schedule to the GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Enfield) Designation Order 2008 is varied as follows:

Immediately after item 5622, the following item is added

Circular Road - Telford Road (A406 Green

For Items 1464, 5826 and 5827, the following is substituted:

25 metres to the east

Warwick the west side between its junction Item 5826 A406 Enfield Road

with North Circular Road-Bowes

Road (A406) and a point 40 metres

to the south

Item 5827 A406 Enfield

Warwick Road

the east side between its junction with North Circular Road-Bowes Road (A406) and the extended common boundary of Nos. 120 and 122 Warwick Road"

Items 5666, 5748, 5749, 5772 and 5773 are deleted.
