PROPOSED SEGREGATED CYCLE TRACK THE A3212 CHELSEA EMBANKMENT, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA

Transport for London wishes to notify the local community that it proposes to build out onto the existing carriageway a length of footway adjacent to A3212 Chelsea Embankment in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea and convert it to a segregated use cycle track. The works are programmed to start on Monday 29th February 2016 and end on Monday 13th June 2016

Schedule – Segregated Use Cycle Track

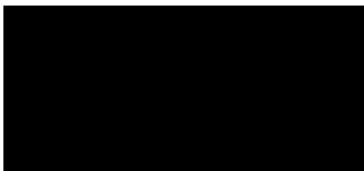
The segregated use cycle track will be on the southern footway of Chelsea Embankment, from its' junction with Chelsea Bridge Road south-westwards for a distance of 39.8 metres.

- Segregated use cycle track will separate the footway by a white line, or physical means to indicate which part of the existing footway will remain as footway, and which part will become a cycle track. Signs and road markings will be used to mark the start and finish of the cycle track, and will make clear where the footway has been converted to a segregated use cycle track.
