**INTRODUCTION**

The site meeting was conducted due to ongoing complaints from local residents of buses from route 384 speeding, causing vibrations, blocking the road and damage to the carriageway.

**Issues**

The following issues were discussed:

1. **Road damage** – [REDACTED] Metroline noted since the last time he visited the site that the road had deteriorated even further. Safety concerns were raised by both Metroline and residents over the state of the road, with it possibly being a trip hazard for pedestrians when crossing the road. GP from Barnet had noted that the road had gotten worse within the last 6-9 months. Pictures 1, a – 1, c show the extent of the damage to the road and 1, d shows the original road that has now been exposed. **Action:** GP Barnet said that they will conduct emergency works on the road.
