Coming into force

The Mayor of London keeps under review the roads and proposed roads which have junctions with GLA roads or with other roads having such junctions and he considers it expedient that certain roads in the London Borough of Newham should become or cease to be GLA Side Roads. Therefore, the Greater London Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 124B(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984a and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of the Council of the London Borough of Newham, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as The GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Newham) Designation Variation Order 2011 and shall come into force on 28 February 2011.

2. Variation

From the date on which this Order comes into force, the Schedule to the GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Newham) Designation Order 2008 is varied as follows:

Immediately after item 1804, the following item is added:

"1805 A13

Newham

NOEL ROAD SERVICE ROAD both sides between its junction with Noel Road and the A13 off slip to

High Street South"
