ROUTES 110, 391, 419, H22, H37 & R68

DATE: 2 FEBRUARY 2018

#### BACKGROUND

- Bus routes in and around Richmond town centre have been reviewed. Currently, there
  are a number of routes that cross the town and travel beyond where required due to a
  lack of standing space. There is also excess capacity on approaches to Richmond from
  Twickenham town centre and Lower Richmond Road. Due to all routes having their
  busiest points elsewhere, removing capacity requires the restructuring of routes.
- Route 110 was restructured to run between Twickenham town centre and West Middlesex University Hospital (WMUH) instead of running between WMUH and Hounslow Bus Station in May 2016. This was to retain links from the Whitton area to WMUH and is not required for network access or capacity.
- 3. BSM 505 approved withdrawal of route 391 between Hammersmith Bus Station and Sands End, Sainsbury's. Introduction of new route 306 between Acton Vale, Hammersmith Bus Station and Sands End was also approved as part of changes proposed to the bus network for the start of the Elizabeth line.

### LOCAL STAKEHOLDER REQUESTS

4. There have been long standing customer requests for new direct links between Whitton Road and the Powder Mill/Hanworth Road corridors to their nearest town centre at Whitton High Street. This has resulted in Vince Cable MP requesting TfL provide a new service. There have also been requests for a new link from Mortlake Road (South Circular Road) to Kew Bridge as currently, local residents do not have a direct link north of Kew Retail Park.

### **PROPOSALS**

- 5. The following restructures are proposed (**see maps** on the last two pages of this paper), subject to route test, confirmed costs and public consultation:
  - Route 419 is extended from Richmond Bus Station to Hounslow Bus Station (covering the freehold section of route 110). It would run via St Margaret's Road, A316 Chertsey Road, Whitton Road, Whitton High Street, Powder Mill Lane then follow the current 110 routeing to Hounslow Bus Station.
  - Route 110 is withdrawn.
  - Route H22 is withdrawn from Richmond, Manor Circus and Twickenham town centre. It would be extended to the previous route 110 stand.
  - Route 493 is withdrawn from Richmond, Manor Circus Homebase to Richmond Bus Station (current route 419 stand).
  - Route R68 is withdrawn from Kew Retail Park to Richmond, Manor Circus (current route H22 stand).
  - Route 391 is rerouted away from Sandycombe Road to run via Mortlake Road (South Circular Road) for Kew Retail Park (currently served by route R68). No bus service would run along Sandycombe Road and passengers would need to walk either to route 65 or use Kew Gardens rail station to complete their journeys.
- 6. These restructures enable the following frequencies reductions, which are also proposed:
  - Route H37 is reduced in frequency from 10 buses per hour (bph) to 8 bph during Monday to Saturday daytimes (covered at busiest point by extended route 419 at St. Margaret's), from 6 to 5 bph during all evenings and from 7.5 to 5 bph on Sundays.
  - Route H22 is reduced in frequency from 5 to 4 bph during Monday to Saturday daytimes (covered at busiest point by extended route 419 at Whitton).
- 7. This package of changes is worthwhile with a disbenefit to net savings ratio of 0.5 to 1.

### BENEFITS AND DISBENEFITS - ROUTES 110, 419, 493, H22

### **New links**

8. The following new links would be created that are forecast to create around 1,100 new trips per weekday. The main links are shown below:

# Frequency enhancement

9. Frequency would be increased on the busiest point of the current route 110 between Powder Mill Lane and Hounslow during Monday to Saturday daytimes, as it would be replaced by route 419 at 4 bph rather than route 110's 3 bph..

### **Broken direct links**

10. Around 850 passengers per weekday that currently have a direct links would need to interchange as a result of the scheme as follows:

11. A further 290 trips would need to walk up to 200-250 metres to access Richmond Station as a consequence of route 493 terminating at Richmond Bus Station.

12. Around 145 trips would need to walk up to 400 metres from Hospital Bridge Road to access either route 419 or 490 to access Richmond Town Centre. This is as a consequence of route H22 being cut back to Twickenham.

### **BENEFITS AND DISBENEFITS - ROUTES 391, R68**

#### New links

13. The following new links would be created that are forecast to create around 360 new trips per weekday. The main links are shown below:

### **Broken direct links**

14. Around 410 trips passengers per weekday that currently have a direct links would need to interchange as a result of the restructuring of routes 391 and R68. This increases to 450 trips when excluding trips that could use the rail service from Kew Gardens to Richmond:

16. A further 830 trips would need to walk between 200-450 metres from Sandycombe Lane stops to access alternative public transport options. No bus route would remain on this road. Around 350 trips would then be able to use routes 65 or one of seven routes from Manor Circus up to a 400 metre walk. Around 180 trips could use rail services from Kew Gardens to Gunnersbury, Turnham Green, Stamford Brook, Ravenscourt Park or Hammersmith to complete their journeys. Around 290 trips could use rail services from Kew Gardens to Richmond between stops up to 400 metres away from both stations or walk to route 65. Sufficient capacity exists on route 65 in this area to meet the additional demand.

### Frequency reduction

17. Frequency is also proposed to be reduced on route 391 from 5 to 3 bph during Monday to Saturday daytimes and from 4 to 2 bph during Sundays and all evenings. A separate package of schemes to withdraw route 391 east of Hammersmith and replacing the withdrawn section with route 306 means the lower frequencies better match demand west of Hammersmith. Replacing route R68 with route 391 would impact around 920 trips per weekday with lower frequencies between Kew and Richmond.

### **IMPLEMENTATION**

### Infrastructure

18. No new stands or toilets are required as a consequence of the proposed changes.

19. New stops would be required on A316 Chertsey Road on proposed route 419 and A205 Mortlake Road (South Circular Road) on proposed route 391. TfL is the highway authority for both roads.

### Consultation

 Consultation would be required for all restructures. Loss of a service along Sandycombe Lane and other broken links may result in significant stakeholder opposition.

#### Route tests

21. Route tests would be required though no issues are expected.

#### Contracts

22. The following routes are proposed for restructure or frequency change as a result of this review:

23. The implementation date of this scheme is selected to coincide with proposed restructures to routes 266, 391 and 440, along with the introduction of routes 218 and 306. A separate paper will be submitted for BSM to close out consultation and changes to costs.


