Just to confirm what I had discussed at our onsite meeting this afternoon.

The Brigade will be satisfied for this route to be used in the areas you are responsible for, that is from the outside of the new station to the new road entrance. This is only deemed satisfactory if the Tower cranes, the hoist, generator are removed and the road made good for use by pedestrians and vehicles and sufficient separation or barriers are installed to prevent people entering the areas still under construction.

Regarding the new internal area of the station entrance, there are procedures in place that London Underground has to follow in relation to bringing areas of construction into use and this includes consultation with the Brigade and as this area is outside your scope of responsibility I will not comment on the suitability of bringing in to use of this area at this time Hope this removes any concerns you may have
