Ref : Dulwich Village :Calton Avenue / Dulwich Village junction
Please can we have a meeting to discuss our plan for the LSP scheme at Dulwich Village: Calton Avenue / Dulwich Village junction.

We are looking at making changes to the signal junction to:

- allow emergency services to access Calton Avenue (currently closed to motor traffic)
- allow cycles to have their own phase across the junction and remove internal stop lines
- remove the staggered ped crossing

This will require signal changes and is intended to be experimental for 6 -12 months
