THE GLA SIDE ROADS (LONDON BOROUGH OF BARNET) DESIGNATION ORDER 2008 VARIATION ORDER 2022

Made 24 August 2022
Coming into force 24 August 2022

The Mayor of London considers it expedient that certain roads in the London Borough of Barnet should become or cease to be GLA Side Roads. Therefore, the Greater London Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 124B(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of the Council of the London Borough of Barnet, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Barnet) Designation Order 2008 Variation Order 2022 and shall come into force on August 2022.

2. Variation

From the date on which this Order comes into force, the schedule to The GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Barnet) Designation Order 2008, is varied as follows:

The GLA Side Roads (London Borough of Barnet) Designation Order 2008 is varied by the provisions of this Order.

In the Schedule items 5625a is added as follows:

Item No.	Route No.	Borough	Street Name	Description
5625a	A406	Barnet	Charter Way	both sides from its junction with A406 North Circular Road to a point 50 metres north-east of the extended north-easternmost building line of Nos. 23 to 28 Kinloss Court, North Circular Road (including the unnamed on-slip road connecting it with A406 North Circular Road).
