Recent reports have shown a link between air pollution and an increased risk of developing dementia.

We believe risk factors, such as air pollution, account for 40% of dementia cases, many of which could be avoided. With almost 1 million people living with dementia in the UK – reducing our risk is extremely important.

It's really encouraging to see the ambition at a local level to reduce air pollution and help reduce the risk of developing dementia.
