The planned works for tonight have now been completed. The cycle lane was scabbed and dried off before the blue MMA was laid on-top. Visually I can see the surface already has a more rough texture, to provide more grip for cyclists. The route has reopened and is safe for cyclists to use.

To reiterate from my previous email - this is a the temporary measure and the full resurfacing of the cycle lanes (northbound and southbound) will be completed at a later date, I will confirm this when agreed with contractors.

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
