
TMAP 2 – KP Northern Aspect





Spectator Loading






KP Stadium Ticket Check Area






KP - Stadium Load Zone

Load Zones with Pre penning of 25 people per pen

Capacity of each loadzone = 25 x 6 (for 5 minute loadings) every 30 Mins = 150 Pax / 30 mins.

Total Capacity = $9 \times 150 = 1350$ every 30 Mins.

(1700 with a 4 minute loading) achieved by pre penning the queue.



Stadium Spectator Loading




Requirements for 3600:

- Realistic movement is 2 hours.


Saffron Lane - Drop Off Routing - CAD to Follow.




Saffron Lane – Drop Off






Saffron Lane – Pick Up Area






TMAP 3 – Enderby Park & Ride – External

3.0 - Command & Control Measures

Emergency Routes

All Emergency routes will remain clear throughout the duration of the implementation of the traffic management services. Any emergency vehicle that approaches a road closure will be given full access. All Traffic Stewards will be briefed with this information.

Emergency RVPs will be agreed with Police and Emergency services and will be detailed here and within the Event Management Plan.

Command Structure

A command and control structure will be in place for this travel plan and will operate from the King Power Stadium Control Room. All SAG and stakeholders will be invited to be present. A working group of the following will operate from this location to communicate between Stadium, Park & Ride Sites and Wembley Stadium

- LCFC Safety Officer
- Wembley Stadium
- EP
- Steer
- National Express

Signing

All signs will comply with Chapter Eight Guidelines and will be produced on Zintec Plate Class II reflectivity. Lettering will be black vinyl on yellow at a minimum x height of 60mm. Signs will be erected in accordance with the New Roads Street Works Act 1991. Trained EP staff members will place signs as directed by the maps and sign schedule within this Plan. All signs will be mounted using metal-framed stanchions and secured by the use of sandbags. Signs will be marked with the EP name and telephone number on the reverse. All signs are maintained in good working order.

A team of Lantra Sector 12D qualified stewards from EP will be working on each event day to erect external traffic management. All staff will wear appropriate uniform in accordance with BS EN 4711994 Class 3 hi-vis clothing.
