Beech Street Interim Scheme - Zero Emission Street

Scheme Location

Beech Street between its junctions with Aldersgate and Silk Street

Thank you for submitting information on the above scheme notification received on the 13th December 2019. The Network Impact Specialist Team (NIST) has reviewed your proposals and based on the information provided are satisfied that the proposed scheme will not have an unduly adverse impact on the network.

Agreed Scheme Information

Implementation of a two-way Zero Emission restriction along the length of Beech St. Access to off street premises (e.g. car parks) will be maintained for non-compliant vehicles. The scheme will be introduced through an experimental traffic order (that will be in place for a maximum of 18 months), before progressing to a permanent change if deemed successful.
