Track and drainage replacement work at Earl's Court and East Putney.

Piccadilly line:

Piccadilly line trains towards Heathrow will call additionally at Ravenscourt Park, Stamford Brook (Westbound only) and Turnham Green. Please note four trains per hour District line shuttle service will operate all day, every day between Acton Town and Ealing Broadway

London Overground:

No London Overground services on Boxing Day.

Rail Replacement bus service

RRBS A: Wimbledon - Hammersmith via Wimbledon Park, Southfields, East Putney, Putney Bridge every 5-10 minutes. Operated by Sullivan.

RRBS B: Wimbledon - Earl's Court via Putney Bridge, Parsons Green, Fulham Broadway, West Brompton every 4-10 minutes. Operated by Abellio London.

RRBS C: Turnham Green - Richmond via Chiswick Park, Gunnersbury, Kew Gardens (Victoria Gate) every 5 minutes (Operating on Boxing Day only). Operated by Metroline Travel. *This service operates all day Boxing Day but only early/late journeys Tuesday – Friday.*

Residual train service.

Due to the nature of the closure and limitations of some of our assets, some train and DMI destinations may not tally. A residual service will run between Edgware Road and Barking/Upminster via Victoria.

Westbound trains departing Barking or Upminster will show as 'District line to Earl's Court' as far as Tower Hill. From Tower Hill to Edgware Road trains and DMIs should show 'Circle line to Edgware Road'.

Eastbound trains departing Edgware Road will show as 'Circle line to South Kensington'. Once at South Kensington the trains will show 'District line to Barking or Upminster'. Platform DMIs will show 'Circle line' at stations between Edgware Road and Mansion House. After Mansion House they will show as 'District line to Barking or Upminster'.

Train Operator scripts are scheduled at key stations to reinforce where the train's ultimate destination is as once they change over, customers may be confused.

Station Specific Advice

West of Earl's Court

- Customers travelling west of Earl's Court should use the Piccadilly line. All Piccadilly line trains will stop at Turnham Green and Ravenscourt Park in both directions and Stamford Brook (westbound only).

Ealing Broadway to central London

- Customers travelling between Ealing Broadway and central London can take the District line to Acton Town and change to the Piccadilly line or use the Central line.

Southfields or Wimbledon Park to central London

- Customers travelling between central London and Southfields or Wimbledon Park must be advised to use the rail replacement bus to Wimbledon and use South West Trains services to/from Central London.

East Putney

- Customers travelling between central London and East Putney must be advised to walk to Putney station to use South West Trains services to London.

West Brompton, Fulham Broadway, Parsons Green and Putney Bridge to central London

- Customers travelling between central London and West Brompton, Fulham Broadway, Parson Green and Putney Bridge must be advised to travel via Earl's Court on the Piccadilly line and use rail replacement bus Service B.

Wimbledon to central London

26th December:

- No District line or South West Train services in operation. Customers are advised to use RRBS A to Hammersmith for the Piccadilly line.

27th December – 30th December:

- Customers should use South West Trains services to London Waterloo. LU tickets will be accepted.

Notting Hill Gate to central London

- Customers travelling to/from Notting Hill Gate should use the Central or Circle line.

Bayswater to central London

- Customers travelling to/from Bayswater should use the Circle line or walk 5 minutes to Queensway for the Central line.

Paddington to central London

- Customers travelling to/from Paddington are advised to use the Hammersmith & City, Circle or Bakerloo lines.

Note: There are no Great Western Railway, Heathrow Express or Heathrow Connect services at Paddington between 24 and 29 December inclusive.

West Kensington

- Not served by the RRBS, use alternative local bus route 28 to Notting Hill Gate and change for the Central line or route 391 to Hammersmith and change for Piccadilly, Hammersmith and City or Circle line services.
- Customers should walk 5 minutes along Barons Court Road to Barons Court station for the Piccadilly line.

Events

- On the 26th December Chelsea F.C will be playing against Bournemouth at Stamford Bridge from 15:00 to 16:45.
- Fulham Road will be closed to all traffic in both directions from 13:30 during the match. Buses towards Wimbledon will therefore serve Stop H and buses towards Earls Court Stop S during these times.



- Supporters travelling to the match using Tube services will be encouraged to use Piccadilly line services to Earl's Court station and continue their journey by foot or alternatively use Piccadilly or District line services to South Kensington station and continue their journey by foot.
- Both routes will be signed between the stadium and station
- Victoria and Hammersmith will also be promoted but walking routes to these stations will NOT be signed – however routes will be indicated on walking maps on publicity prior to the match.
- For egress, LU will advertise that we expect 30 minute queues into Earl's Court which will hopefully incentivise some supporters to walk the slightly longer distance to South Kensington station.

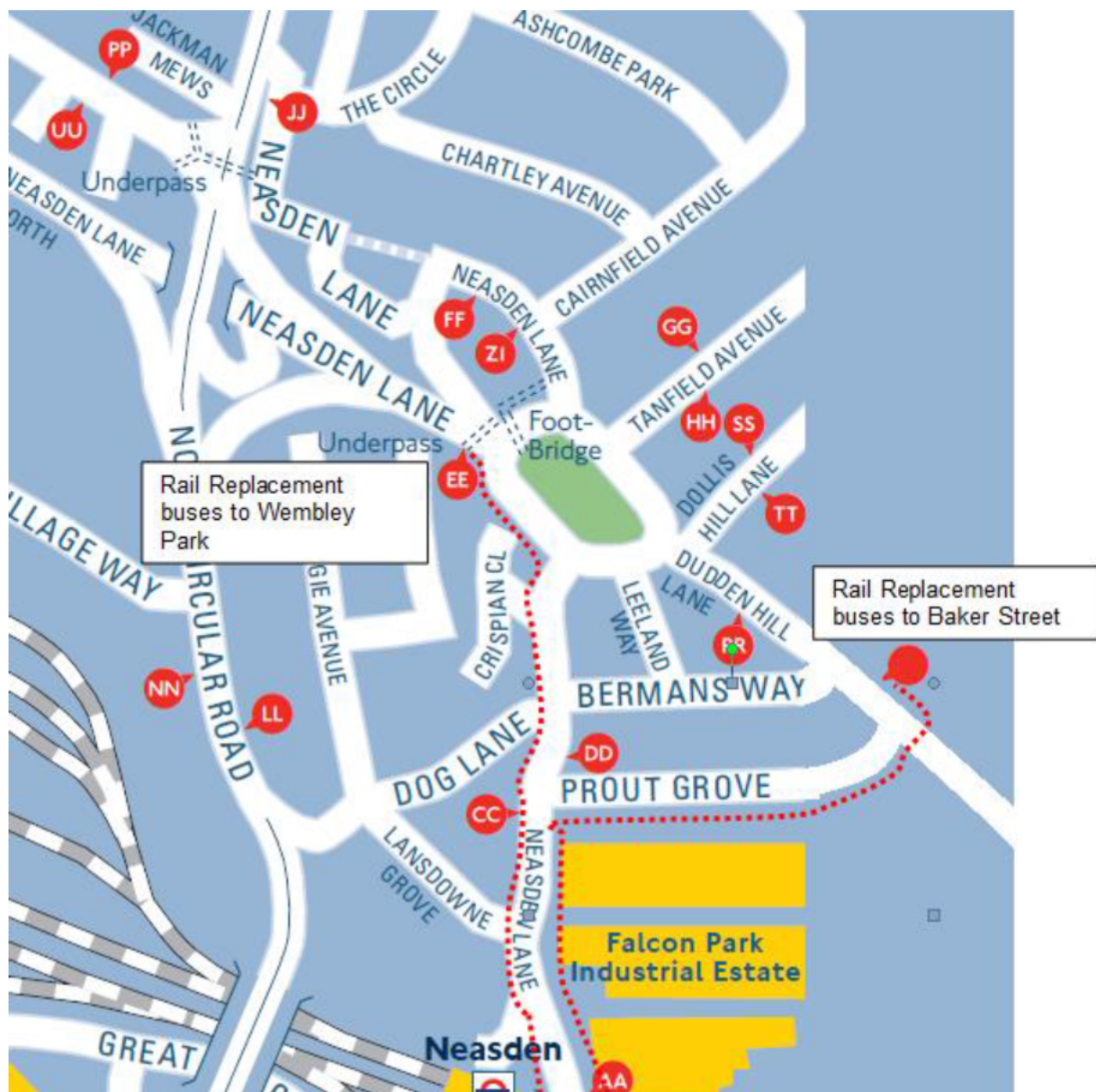

Owing to a burst water main which has caused serious traffic congestion in the Willesden/Dollis Hill area, we have implemented a diversion to the rail replacement (Route D) service.

Buses are routed directly via Dudden Hill Lane between Neasden Roundabout and Dollis Hill.

Buses towards Baker Street will serve the existing bus stop (No point letter but called "Musgrave Road") in Dudden Hill Lane opposite Prout Grove.

Buses towards Wembley Park will serve Stop EE on Neasden Lane by the roundabout/North Circular Road on-slip. Customers at Neasden Station should use local bus 297 between there and Wembley Park. (Tickets are valid but customers will need to touch in when boarding).

Passengers travelling between central London and stations West Ham – Upminster must be advised to use c2c train services between Fenchurch Street/Liverpool Street, West Ham, Barking and Upminster or Jubilee line services to/from West Ham.

Passengers travelling between central London and stations between Tower Hill to Bromley-by-Bow must be advised to make full use of alternative Underground lines to connect with the rail replacement bus services at Tower Hill, Aldgate, Mile End and Canning Town.

London Overground

All weekend London Overground trains will not call at Whitechapel (Station closed) due to Crossrail construction works. Use local buses via any reasonable route.

Alternative Transport

Rail Replacement bus service

RRBS A: Tower Hill to Canning Town via Aldgate/Aldgate East, Whitechapel, Stepney Green, Mile End, Bow Road, Bromley-by-Bow, Canning Town operated by Sullivan Buses.

Fastest Journey to/from

Aldgate

- Use the Circle or Metropolitan lines if travelling to/from stations north or west of.
- Use local bus routes 15, 25, 40, 78, 100 or 205 if travelling to/from stations south or east of.

Aldgate East

- If travelling from the east, use the RRBS.
- If travelling from the west, take the Circle and Metropolitan lines to Aldgate, which is a short walk from Aldgate East.

Blackfriars

- Use local bus route 388.
- Alternatively, take Thameslink services to/from Blackfriars National Rail station.
- Or, use the Jubilee line to/from Southwark station, which is a 13 minute walk from Blackfriars station. Alternatively, take local bus routes 45, 63 or 100.

Bow Road

- For central London take RRBS or local bus routes 25, 205 or 425 to Mile End for the Central line.
- Alternatively, use the DLR from nearby Bow Church station

Bromley-by-Bow

- For central London take RRBS to Mile End. Change there for the Central line.

Cannon Street

- Take the Central line to/from Bank is a short walk from Mansion House.
- Alternatively use local bus routes 15 or 17.

Embankment

- Use Bakerloo or Northern line services.
- Alternatively use local bus routes 11, 15 or 23.

Mile End

- For central London or Stratford, take the Central line.

Monument

- Take the Central, Northern or Waterloo & City lines or DLR from Bank station.
- Alternatively use local bus routes 15, 17, 21, 35, 40, 43, 47, 48, 133, 141 or 149.

Stepney Green

- For central London take RRBS A to Aldgate for the Circle line.
- For Stratford take local bus route 25.

Temple

- Use local bus routes 1, 4, 11, 15, 23, 26, 59, 68, 76, 91, 168, 171, 172, 188, 243 or 341 to/from Aldwych/Strand, which is a short walk to Temple station

West Ham

- For central London or Canning Town use the Jubilee line or DLR.

Whitechapel

- For central London take RRBS A to Aldgate for the Circle line.
- For Stratford take local bus route 25.
