Track and drainage replacement work in the Earl's Court area and Network Rail Engineering work between Gunnersbury and Richmond.

Fastest journey to/from Central London

- Passengers travelling between Richmond and central London should be advised to use South West Trains services between Richmond and Vauxhall or Waterloo. Alternatively they should be advised to use London Overground on Saturday only, or alternatively use RRBS C to Turnham Green and then use the Piccadilly line which will be stopping at that station during the weekend.
