

Fares on TfL bus services – 31 January 2018

The following applies on all TfL bus routes:

Oyster Pay As You Go - £1.50 for a single journey or **75p** for discount schemes.

Contactless Payment Cards - £1.50 for a single journey.

Capping for Oyster Pay As You Go & Contactless Payment Card travel - limits the amount paid for bus and tram travel over 24 hours [starting at 0430 each day] to **£4.50**.

Capping for Contactless Payment Card travel only - limits the amount paid for all bus and tram travel from 0430 on Monday to 0429 on the following Monday to **£21.20**.

Different caps apply to discount schemes or if Tube, DLR, London Overground, National Rail or TfL Rail services are also used.

NEW Hopper Fare - allows customers using Oyster Pay As You Go or Contactless Payment Card to make unlimited bus or tram journeys within 60 minutes of validating on first bus or tram for £1.50. Customers must use the same card.

All Oyster cards, passes and tickets, and accompanying photocards, must be produced for inspection on demand. A Penalty Fare is payable or prosecution may occur if the customer fails to show on demand a ticket or pass valid for the whole of their journey, or a validated Oyster or Contactless Payment card.

Routes serving Potters Bar and Potters Bar PlusBus

English National Concessionary Companions Passes

Hertfordshire County Council issued passes with 'C+' on them allow a companion (travelling with the pass holder) to travel free on any journey that starts within the points shown below. Not valid for any journey that starts in Greater London.

Potters Bar PLUSBUS
