Bus service changes, 16 June – 28 July 2017 inclusive

This document sets out bus route service changes that are confirmed as going ahead; the information is correct to the date we publish, but is subject to change at short notice for operational reasons.

We publish this report every fortnight and highlight service changes two weeks previous and four weeks ahead of the issue date.

- **London Bridge station** – Until February 2018 Tooley Street is closed to eastbound traffic due to the redevelopment of London Bridge station. Routes **47, 343, 381, RVI, NI99** and **N381** are diverted eastbound. [Read more about the closure of Tooley Street](#)
- **Blackwall Tunnel overnight works** – The Blackwall Tunnel is closed for planned maintenance on the following dates between 00:01 and 08:00 Sunday mornings: 2 July, 16 July, 6 August, 20 August 2017 (future dates to be confirmed). During these times route **108** runs in two sections: Stratford – Canning Town and North Greenwich – Lewisham. The Jubilee line provides a connection between Canning Town and North Greenwich.
- **Kidbrooke Park Road** – Until early September 2017 buses on route **178** are diverted and reduced in frequency because of works in Kidbrooke Park Road.
- **Parliament Square** – Until late August 2017 there are restrictions or closed roads around Parliament Square. Routes **3, 11, 12, 24, 53, 87, 88, 91, 148, 159, 211, 453, N3, N11, N44, N87, NI09, NI36, NI55** and **N381** may be delayed, diverted or stop short of their normal destination.
- **Uxbridge High Street** – Until late August 2017 routes **427, U3, U4, U7** and **N207** towards Uxbridge, and route **U1** towards Ruislip, are diverted, and do not serve High Street (Civic Centre bus stop). This is due to utility works in the area.
- **Upper Street and Essex Road** – Until early August 2017 bus routes **38, 56, 73, 341, 476, N38** and **N73** serving Essex Road are diverted northbound. This is due to water main replacement work by Thames Water. Essex Road is closed northbound near Islington Green. Details of buses affected by further phases of this work will be shown here when known.

- **Beckenham High Street** – Until August 2018 buses on routes **54, 162, 194, 227, 352, 354, 358, 367** and **N3** are disrupted or diverted because of High Street improvement works.
- **Fulham Road** – Until late September 2017 bus routes serving Fulham Road and Kings Road may be delayed, diverted or stop short of their destination. This is due to gas main replacement work in Fulham Road, and affected traffic diverting to Kings Road. Routes affected: **11, 14, 19, 22, 49, 211, 319, 328, 345, 414** and **C3**. - **Chamberlayne Road and Brondesbury Park** – Between Monday 17 July and late September 2017 routes **6, 28, 52, 187, 302** and **452** are diverted or stop short of their normal destination in the Chamberlayne Road and Brondesbury Park areas. This is due to utility works in the area. More details will be shown at tfl.gov.uk/TempBusChanges shortly.

6	Willesden – Aldwych	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses now serve Park Lane and Piccadilly and no longer serve Oxford Street and Regent Street.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>
8	Tottenham Court Road – Bow	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses now permanently start and finish at Tottenham Court Road station, serving stops in High Holborn and New Oxford Street (different to those previously served). They no longer serve Oxford Circus. Route 8 has been temporarily starting and finishing at Tottenham Court Road since 2013.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>
43	London Bridge – Friern Barnet	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday peak hours buses run every 6-7 minutes (previously every 5-6 minutes)
73	Oxford Circus – Stoke Newington	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses now start and finish at Oxford Circus and no longer serve Oxford Circus – Victoria.</p> <p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday peak hours buses run every 4-5 minutes (previously every 3-4 minutes) Sunday daytime and each evening buses run every 7-8 minutes (previously every 6 minutes) <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>
172	Clerkenwell Green – Brockley Rise	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses now start and finish at Clerkenwell Green, serving Farringdon, and no longer serve Ludgate Circus – St Paul's.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>

242	St Paul's – Homerton Hospital	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses now start and finish at St Paul's and no longer serve St Paul's – Tottenham Court Road.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p> <p>Buses now run more often:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytime buses run every 7-8 minutes (previously every 10-11 minutes) Sunday daytime and each evening buses run every 10 minutes (previously every 12 minutes)
390	Victoria – Archway	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses now start and finish at Victoria, serving Oxford Street, Park Lane and Hyde Park Corner, and no longer serve Marble Arch – Notting Hill Gate.</p> <p>Buses now run more often:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytimes buses run every 6 minutes (previously every 8 minutes), with additional journeys towards Archway in the morning peak hours Sunday daytime and each evening buses run every 10 minutes (previously every 12 minutes) <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>
N73	Oxford Circus – Walthamstow	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses now start and finish at Oxford Circus and no longer serve Oxford Circus – Victoria.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016</p> <p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Friday and Saturday nights buses run every 15 minutes (previously every 12 minutes)

48	London Bridge – Walthamstow	To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytimes buses now run every 10 minutes (previously every 8 minutes)
70	Chiswick Business Park – South Kensington	New, more environmentally friendly diesel single deck buses introduced. London United now operate the route (previously Tower Transit).
120	Northolt – Hounslow	New, more environmentally friendly diesel-electric hybrid double deck buses introduced. Metroline now operate the route (previously London United).
260	White City – Golders Green	New, more environmentally friendly diesel-electric hybrid double deck buses progressively introduced.
302	Mill Hill Broadway – Kensal Rise	The new buses previously announced are no longer being introduced on this route.
E3	Greenford – Chiswick	To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytimes buses run every 7-8 minutes (previously every 6-7 minutes)
R70	Hampton – Richmond	The new buses previously announced are now being progressively introduced on this route from September 2017.

253	Hackney Central – Euston station	To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytimes buses will run every 6 minutes (previously every 5-6 minutes), with additional journeys towards Euston in the morning peak hours
CI	Victoria – White City	To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytimes buses will run every 12 minutes (previously every 10-11 minutes)
R68	Hampton Court – Kew	New, more environmentally friendly diesel single deck buses progressively introduced from July 2017.

3	Trafalgar Square – Crystal Palace	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Trafalgar Square and will no longer serve Regent Street or Oxford Circus.</p> <p>There will be no change at this time to route N3, which will continue to run between Oxford Circus and Bromley North.</p> <p>We intend to extend routes 3 and N3 to Russell Square when Elizabeth line services start running from Tottenham Court Road.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>
22	Oxford Circus – Putney Common	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Oxford Circus, serving Berkeley Square, and will no longer serve Green Park – Piccadilly and Piccadilly Circus.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p> <p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Monday to Friday peak hours buses will run every 7-8 minutes (previously every 6 minutes), with additional journeys towards Oxford Circus in the morning peak hours• Monday to Friday off-peak hours and Saturday daytime buses will run every 8 minutes (previously every 7-8 minutes)• Sunday daytime and each evening buses will run every 12 minutes (previously every 10 minutes)
137	Marble Arch – Streatham Hill	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Marble Arch and will no longer serve Oxford Street or Oxford Circus.</p> <p>There is no change to route N137.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>

382	Southgate – Millbrook Park	Some buses towards Southgate will be retimed to better co-ordinate with Northern Line trains from Mill Hill East station. Metroline will now operate the route (previously Arriva).
384	Cockfosters – Barnet, Quinta Drive	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are removing the additional journeys currently provided at school times, and changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytimes buses will run every 20 minutes (previously every 15 minutes)
C2	Regent Street - Parliament Hill Fields	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Regent Street / Conduit Street and will no longer serve Berkeley Square – Victoria.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>
N22	Oxford Circus - Fulwell	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Oxford Circus, serving Berkeley Square, and will no longer serve Green Park – Piccadilly and Piccadilly Circus.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>

17	Archway – London Bridge	New, more environmentally friendly diesel-electric hybrid double deck buses progressively introduced.
186	Northwick Park Hospital – Brent Cross	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday between 06:00 and 07:00 buses will run every 12 minutes (previously every 20 minutes)
C11	Archway – Brent Cross	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytimes buses will run every 10 minutes (previously every 8 minutes)
