This document sets out bus route service changes that are confirmed as going ahead; the information is correct to the date we publish, but is subject to change at short notice for operational reasons.

3	Trafalgar Square – Crystal Palace	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses start and finish at Trafalgar Square and no longer serve Regent Street or Oxford Circus.</p> <p>There is no change at this time to route N3, which continues to run between Oxford Circus and Bromley North.</p> <p>We intend to extend routes 3 and N3 to Russell Square when Elizabeth line services start running from Tottenham Court Road.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>
14	Putney Heath – Warren Street	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we've changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Monday to Saturday daytime buses run about every 8 minutes. (previously about every 5 minutes in Monday to Friday peak hours and about every 6 – 7 minutes during the day)• Sunday and each evening buses run about every 12 minutes (previously about every 10 – 11 minutes).• Friday and Saturday nights buses run every 12 minutes (previously every 10 minutes)• Sunday to Thursday nights buses run every 15 minutes (unchanged).

22	Putney Common - Oxford Circus	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses start and finish at Oxford Circus, serving Berkeley Square, and no longer serve Green Park – Piccadilly Circus.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p> <p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we've changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday peak hours buses run every 7-8 minutes (previously every 6 minutes), with additional journeys towards Oxford Circus in the morning peak hours Monday to Friday off-peak hours and Saturday daytime buses run every 8 minutes (previously every 7-8 minutes) Sunday daytime and each evening buses run every 12 minutes (previously every 10 minutes)
74	Putney – Baker Street station	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we've changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytime buses run about every 10 minutes (previously about every 8 minutes) Sunday daytime and each evening buses run about every 12 minutes (previously every 10-12 minutes)
137	Marble Arch – Streatham Hill	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses start and finish at Marble Arch and no longer serve Oxford Street or Oxford Circus.</p> <p>There is no change to route N137.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>
382	Southgate – Millbrook Park	<p>Some buses towards Southgate have been retimed to better co-ordinate with Northern Line trains from Mill Hill East station. Metroline now operate the route (previously Arriva).</p>

384	Cockfosters – Barnet, Quinta Drive	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have removed the additional journeys previously provided at school times, and changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytimes buses run every 20 minutes (previously every 15 minutes)
C2	Regent Street – Parliament Hill Fields	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses start and finish at Regent Street / Conduit Street and no longer serve Berkeley Square – Victoria.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>

N22	Oxford Circus – Fulwell	<p>We've changed how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses start and finish at Oxford Circus, serving Berkeley Square, and no longer serve Green Park – Piccadilly Circus.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016.</p>

17	Archway – London Bridge	Environmentally friendly diesel-electric hybrid double deck buses progressively introduced.
63	Honor Oak – King's Cross	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we've changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytime buses run about every 7 – 8 minutes, with additional journeys in Monday to Friday peak hours (previously about every 5 – 6 minutes) Sunday daytime and each evening buses run every 10 minutes (previously every 8 minutes)
186	Northwick Park Hospital – Brent Cross	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we've changed the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday between 06:00 and 07:00 buses run every 12 minutes (previously every 20 minutes)

363	Crystal Palace – Elephant & Castle	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we've changed the frequency.</p> <p>During Monday to Friday peak hours additional buses run on the route.</p>

31	Camden Town – White City	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Sunday daytime buses will run every 7 – 8 minutes (previously every 6 minutes)

E9	Yeading, Barnhill Estate – Ealing Broadway	<p>Accessible fixed bus stops introduced in Ayles Road, Stratford Road and Greenway to replace existing Hail & Ride arrangements.</p>

395	Harrow – Greenford	<p>Accessible fixed bus stops introduced in Dabbs Hill Lane, Haydock Avenue, Southwell Avenue and Newmarket Avenue to replace existing Hail & Ride arrangements.</p>
R70	Hampton, The Avenue – Richmond, Manor Circus	<p>The last three journeys towards Hampton retimed to better co-ordinate with District Line trains at Richmond station.</p>

243	Wood Green – Waterloo	<p>New, more environmentally friendly diesel-electric hybrid double deck buses progressively introduced.</p>
