Bus service changes, 02 June – 14 July 2017 inclusive

This document sets out bus route service changes that are confirmed as going ahead; the information is correct to the date we publish, but is subject to change at short notice for operational reasons.

We publish this report every fortnight and highlight service changes two weeks previous and four weeks ahead of the issue date.

- **Romford, South Street** – From 15 May until 25 June, buses in Romford town centre are diverted while Western Road is closed eastbound. Routes **5, 66, 86, 103, 128, 165, 174, 175, 193, 247, 248, 252, 294, 296, 347, 365, 370, 375, 496, 498, 499, 648, 649, 650, 651, 686, N15 and N86** are diverted along Victoria Road. In addition between 19–25 June westbound stop Q in Western Road will not be served. [Read more about the alternative bus stops.](#)
- **Blackwall Tunnel** –The tunnel will be closed for planned maintenance on the following dates between 00:01 and 08:00 Sunday morning; 21 May, 4 & 18 June, Route **108** will run in two sections; Lewisham – North Greenwich and Stratford – Canning Town. The Jubilee line will provide connection between the two locations. We will review this arrangement after 18 June 2017, and may continue it during future weekend closures. - **Fulham Road** - From 2 May until late September 2017 bus routes serving Fulham Road and Kings Road may be delayed, diverted or stop short of their destination. This is due to gas main replacement work in Fulham Road, and affected traffic diverting to Kings Road. Routes affected: **11, 14, 19, 22, 49, 211, 319, 328, 345, 414 and C3**
- **Lancaster Gate** - Until 22 June 2017 route 46 will stop short of its normal destination. This is due to resurfacing works while we build the East-West Cycle Superhighway. [Read more about the works at Lancaster Gate](#)
- **Essex Road** - Between Monday 17 April and early August 2017 bus routes **38, 56, 73, 341, 476, N38 and N73** serving Essex Road are diverted northbound. This is due to water main replacement work by Thames Water. Essex Road is closed northbound near Islington Green. [Read more about the bus diversions at Essex Road](#)

- **Parliament Square** – Between 24 April and late August there are restrictions or closed roads around Parliament Square. Routes **3, 11, 12, 24, 53, 87, 88, 91, 148, 159, 211, 453, N3, N11, N44, N87, N109, N136, N155** and **N381** maybe delayed, diverted or stop short of their normal destination. - **London Bridge station** - Tooley Street is closed to eastbound traffic from 3 May 2016 until February 2018 due to the redevelopment of London Bridge station. Routes **47, 343, 381, RVI, N199** and **N381** are diverted eastbound. [Read more about the closure of Tooley Street.](#)
- **Beckenham** – Between 11 March 2017 and August 2018 buses on routes **54, 162, 194, 227, 352, 354, 358, 367** and **N3** will be disrupted or diverted because of High Street improvement works. [Read more about the bus route diversions at Beckenham](#)
- **Kidbrooke** – From 25 June until early September buses on route **178** will be diverted and disrupted because of works on Kidbrooke Park Road.
- **Uxbridge** – Between 1 June and late August 2017 routes **427, U3, U4, U7** and **N207** towards Uxbridge are diverted, and will not serve High Street (Civic Centre bus stop). This is due to utility works in the area. [Read more about the bus diversions at Uxbridge](#)

Friday and Saturday nights buses will run every 20 minutes (previously every 15 minutes).
217	Waltham Cross – Turnpike Lane	New, more environmentally friendly diesel double deck buses progressively introduced. Sullivan Buses will now operate the route (previously Metroline).
254	Holloway – Aldgate station	Environmentally friendly diesel-hybrid New Routemaster double deck buses progressively introduced.

73	Oxford Circus - Stoke Newington	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Oxford Circus and will no longer serve Oxford Circus – Victoria. Route 390 will be rerouted to provide this connection.</p> <p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday daytime buses will run every 5 minutes (previously every 3-4 minutes). Sunday and each evening buses will run every 7 -8 minutes (previously every 6 minutes) <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016</p>
172	Clerkenwell Green - Brockley Rise	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Clerkenwell Green, serving Farringdon and will no longer serve Ludgate Circus - St Paul's.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016</p>
242	St Paul's - Homerton Hospital	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at St Paul's and will no longer serve St Paul's – Tottenham Court Road.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016</p>
390	Victoria - Archway	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Victoria, serving Oxford Street, Park Lane and Hyde Park Corner and will no longer serve Marble Arch – Notting Hill Gate.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016</p> <p>Buses will run more often:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytime buses will run every 6 minutes, with additional morning peak time enhancements. N73	Oxford Circus - Walthamstow	<p>We're changing how some buses serve central London.</p> <p>Buses will start and finish at Oxford Circus and will no longer serve Oxford Circus – Victoria. Route 390 will be rerouted to provide this connection.</p> <p>We consulted on this change at the end of 2016</p> <p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we have changed the frequency;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Friday and Saturday nights buses will run every 15 minutes (previously every 12 minutes).
