Permanent Bus Changes

29 June to 10 August 2018

This summary lists permanent bus changes that have been confirmed. The information is correct to the date shown below, but is subject to change for operational reasons.

We publish this summary every two weeks, normally on a Monday evening (Tuesday evening if the Monday is a Public Holiday). It includes confirmed permanent changes up to two weeks before and up to four weeks after the Friday prior to the publication date.

Permanent* changes we list:

- New route
- Route withdrawn
- Route extended
- Route cut back
- Change to routing
- Change to frequency
- Change to service coverage (e.g. evening / night service withdrawn or added)
- Significant additional journey added
- Significant additional journey withdrawn
- Change to timetable (on routes / journeys designed for schools only)
- New fixed bus stop(s), if replacing 'Hail and Ride'
- New buses (if all or most buses on a route)
- Change of vehicle type (e.g. single deck buses replaced by double deck buses) (if all or most buses on a route)

* including seasonal changes (e.g. summer only route extension / frequency increase) and very long-term temporary changes (e.g. in operation for several years)

We do not list:

- Change of operator
- Change to timetable (except on routes / journeys designed for schools)
- Change to individual bus stop(s)
- New buses (if not all or most buses on a route)
- Change of vehicle type (e.g. single deck buses replaced by double deck buses) (if not all or most buses on a route)
