6 April to 18 May 2018

This summary lists permanent bus changes that have been confirmed. The information is correct to the date shown below, but is subject to change for operational reasons.

We publish this summary every two weeks, normally on a Monday evening (Tuesday evening if the Monday is a Public Holiday). It includes confirmed permanent changes up to two weeks before and up to four weeks after the Friday prior to the publication date.

Permanent* changes we list:

- New route
- Route withdrawn
- Route extended
- Route cut back
- Change to routing
- Change to frequency
- Significant additional journey added
- Significant additional journey withdrawn
- Change to timetable (routes / journeys designed for schools only)
- New fixed bus stops, replacing 'Hail and Ride' (if more than one stop)
- New buses (if all or most buses on a route)

* including seasonal (e.g. summer only route extension / frequency increase)

- Change of operator
- Change to timetable (except routes / journeys designed for schools)
- Change to individual bus stop(s)
