

Transport for London PUBLIC NOTICE:

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (LONDON BOROUGH OF HACKNEY) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order would be to impose a speed limit of 20 MPH on the:
 - a) A10 GLA Road – Stoke Newington High Street, Stamford Hill, Manse Road, Evering Road, Rectory Road and Northwold Road between Amhurst Road and the Borough boundary between the London Boroughs of Hackney and Haringey;
 - b) A503 GLA Road – Seven Sisters Road between the London Boroughs of Hackney and Haringey and the London Boroughs of Hackney and Islington;

and all GLA Side Roads - Red Route returns of these roads in the London Borough of Hackney. The Order will also consolidate all existing 20 MPH Orders in the London Borough of Hackney.

3. The roads which would be affected by the Order are GLA Main Roads and all GLA Side Roads - Red Route returns of these roads as listed in article 2 above.
4. The roads affected are currently subject to a permanent speed limit of 30 MPH.
5.
