

Good afternoon

I am writing to advise you that Hampton Court Road, between the Palace Rbt and Church Grove will be closed for overnight works on Sun 13th and Mon 14th Sept (between 7pm-5am) to facilitate the implementation of a temporary cycling scheme outside the Palace. For information I attach the planned diversion route for all traffic. Buses will need to be diverted during these times, I have attached a bus diversion request form for the nights of the 13th and 14th.

Part of these works involves construction of a temporary bus stop border as shown on the attached drawing. The works for this will commence during the evening closure on the 13th September and continue potentially into the next 3 days (this could be less). We will therefore require the bus stop to be temporarily closed from 6pm on the 13th September. I attach the bus stop suspension request form. We will be suspending the parking bays adjacent to this stop for the same time period and I trust it will be possible to use this area for a dolly stop whilst the works are undertaken.
