Re: the request in red text below, I am minded to ask our term consultant to put together a price to undertake a proper assessment (shortly after completion of the scheme) with a written assessment on the impact of both the bus stop boarder and the removal of the bend hatching, with video monitoring over the course of a week or similar. This will include an assessment of the points you detail below. These are 2 of the main concerns raised by the many complainants. Re: Castelnau – previous estimate from end of July was approx. £100k for Phase 1 of works, so will stick with that for now until he's back from leave.

Re: HCR – that's odd that you haven't received any further confirmation from the Network Impact team, as their email on Friday suggested that a formal TMAN notification was submitted/completed. I suspect they are seeking some written assurances about monitoring the bus stop boarder, providing more detail than our emails from last week. I'll confirm this; however in the meantime, could you put together a brief monitoring strategy/note (at most 1

page word doc) about the video monitoring mentioned last week, including the following details:

- Extents and map
- Indicative time/dates (ie length of video monitoring, how soon after scheme completion, etc)
- Scope of monitoring:
 - a. impact of bus dwell times on general traffic
 - b. impact of bus arrival pattern and dwell times on bus cage length (ie in case the 25m length is insufficient for the actual arrival pattern)
 - c. interactions between cyclists and pedestrian at bus stop boarder zebra crossing

Hope that makes sense? I can then send this over to Network Impacts and confirm that this will tie-off the formal TMAN notification. Will come back to you if I hear anything else from them.
