The MTS sets out the Mayor's vision to transform walking, cycling and public transport to reduce people's dependency on cars and enable them to choose cleaner, healthier ways to travel, as well as his plan to create opportunities for more housing.

Transport for London, on behalf of the Mayor, is consulting on the draft MTS. This session is for our supplier and industry groups, and will focus on:

- **Healthy streets and healthy people** - Streets make up 80 per cent of London's public spaces - making them Healthy Streets will improve the quality of life for everyone in London.
- **A good public transport experience** - Public transport is the most efficient way for people to travel longer distances. A seamless, 'whole-journey' experience will provide an attractive alternative to using the car.
- **New homes and jobs** - London needs 50,000 new homes every year to meet demand, plus around 1.2 million more jobs are forecast by 2041. We have an opportunity to reshape London and make sure it grows in a way that improves the city.
