Having spoken to the Asset Ops response desk just now, is entitled to contact them with requests and queries about our assets. If one of our Borough officer colleagues sees something on site that they believe is unsafe, then the response desk is the right way to get that concern assessed and potentially changed.

In this particular instance the situation on street is more complex than it first appeared, and cyclists are being directed into the other side of the carriageway, hence the pedestrian signals being bagged. But this is not necessarily clear on street.

<u>In my opinion</u> no email to the response desk should be seen as a 'change request' or directive, as it would first require an assessment by a skilled engineer or contractor.



The low level signal on Calton Avenue phase K(S) is currently <u>unbagged</u> and informing cyclists of when to stop and go, but the pedestrian crossing phase in front of it (H) is bagged.
