## **THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (HACKNEY) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A503 GLA SIDE ROAD (FINSBURY PARK ROAD) VARIATION ORDER 2009**

*Made* 19<sup>th</sup> June 2009

*Coming into force* 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2009

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

### **1. Commencement and citation**

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Hackney) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 A503 GLA Side Road (Finsbury Park Road) Variation Order 2009, and shall come into force on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2009.

### **2. Variations**

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Hackney) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007<sup>b</sup> is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 In Schedule 3A item 2. (in the vicinity of (A503)) is substituted as follows:
  2. (in the vicinity of SEVEN SISTERS ROAD (A503)) FINSBURY PARK ROAD, the south-west side from a point 10 metres south-east of the extended north-western building line of No. 296 Seven Sisters Road for a distance of 7 metres in a south-easterly direction .
- 2 Schedule 3A (in the vicinity of (A503)) the following text is added after item 2 as follows:
  3. FINSBURY PARK ROAD, the south-west side from a point 23 metres south-east of the extended north-western building line of No. 296 Seven Sisters Road to a point 6 metres South-eastwards.No Stopping on any day Any Day 7am - 7pm Except loading max 20 mins and disabled persons' vehicles max 3 hours

- 3 Schedule 4 (in the vicinity of (A503)) the following text is added after item 17 as follows:
18. (in the vicinity of (A503)) FINSBURY PARK ROAD, the south-west side from a point 17 metres south-east of the extended north-western building line of No. 296 Seven Sisters Road to a point 6 metres South-eastwards.
- No Stopping At Any Time
