### THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (HARINGEY) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A503 SEVEN SISTERS ROAD VARIATION ORDER 2020

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

#### 1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 A503 Seven Sisters Road Variation Order 2020 and shall come into force on 17 October 2020

#### 2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007<sup>b</sup> is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 Schedule 3B the following text is added after item 7 as follows:  
8. A503 (A503), the south side from a point 41.2 metres northeast of the extended western building line of No.820 Seven Sisters Road to a point 56.2 metres northeast of the extended western building line No.820 Seven Sisters Road.  
No Stopping Mon-Sat 7am - 7pm Except 10am-4pm loading max 20 mins
- 2 In Schedule 4 item 124. is substituted as follows: 124. A503 (SEVEN SISTERS ROAD), the south-east side from a point 41.2 metres northeast of the extended western building line of No. 820 Seven Sisters Road to a point 27 metres south-west of the extended common

boundary of Nos. 778 to 796 Seven Sisters Road and No. 798 Seven Sisters Road.

- 3      Schedule 4 the following text is added after item 135 as follows:  
136. A503 (A503), the south side from a point 56.2 metres northeast of the extended western building line No.820 Seven Sisters Road to its junction with the A10 High Road.
