Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

### **1. Commencement and citation**


This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads And GLA Side Roads(Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 A10 GLA Side Road (Woodside Gardens) Variation Order 2008, and shall come into force on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2008.

### **2. Variations**

The GLA Roads And GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007<sup>b</sup> is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 Schedule 2B the following text is added after item 24 as follows:  
25. (in the vicinity of (A10)) WOODSIDE GARDENS, the north-west side from a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Bruce Grove to a point 12 metres to the north-east .  
Parking at any time
- 2 In Schedule 4 item 128. (in the vicinity of BRUCE GROVE (A10) (A10)) is substituted as follows: 128. (in the vicinity of BRUCE GROVE (A10) (A10)) WOODSIDE GARDENS, the north-west side from its junction with Bruce Grove to a point 10 metres to the north-east.
