

## GLA 2011 No.0032

### THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (HARINGEY) RED ROUTE (CLEARWAY) CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 VARIATION ORDER 2011

*Made* 14<sup>th</sup> September 2011

*Coming into force* 24<sup>th</sup> September 2011

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

#### 1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route (Clearway) Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 Variation Order 2011, and shall come into force on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2011.

#### 2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route (Clearway) Consolidation Traffic Order 2007<sup>b</sup> is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  10. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 44 metres north of the northern kerbline of Devonshire Hill Lane to a point 11 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time
- 2 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  1. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from the extended common boundary of Nos. 65 & 67 Great Cambridge Road to a point 7 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time
- 3 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  2. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 10 metres north of the extended common boundary of Nos. 41 & 43 Great Cambridge Road to a point 20.5 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time



- 4 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  3. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 15.5 metres north of the northern kerblines of Cambridge Gardens to a point 14 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time
- 5 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  4. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the east side from a point 8.4 metres south of the borough boundary between the London Borough of Enfield and the London Borough of Haringey to a point 30 metres southwards.  
Parking at any time
- 6 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  5. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the east side from a point 7.6 metres north of the extended common boundary of Nos. 98 & 100 Great Cambridge Road to a point 37 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time
- 7 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  6. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 66 metres north of the northern kerblines of Devonshire Hill Lane to a point 30 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time
- 8 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  7. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the east side from a point 10 metres south of the southern kerblines of Devonshire Hill Lane to a point 40 metres southwards.  
Parking at any time
- 9 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  8. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the east side from a point 52 metres north of the northern kerblines of Devonshire Hill Lane to a point 15.5 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time
- 10 In Schedule 3A the following text is added as follows:
  9. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 7.5 metres north of the northern kerblines of Mayfair Gardens to a point 20.5 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time
- 11 In Schedule 3B the following text is added as follows:
  1. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from the extended common boundary of Nos. 65 & 67 Great Cambridge Road to a point 6.6 metres southwards.  
Parking at any time Disabled Persons' Vehicles Only
- 12 In Schedule 3B the following text is added as follows:
  2. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the east side from a point 1 metre north of the extended common boundary of Nos. 98 & 100 Great Cambridge Road to a point 6.6 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time Disabled Persons' Vehicles Only

- 13 In Schedule 3B the following text is added as follows:  
3. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the east side from a point 46 metres north of the northern kerbline of Devonshire Hill Lane to a point 6.6 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time Disabled Persons' Vehicles Only
- 14 In Schedule 3B the following text is added as follows:  
4. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 3.5 metres north of the extended common boundary of Nos. 41 & 43 Great Cambridge Road to a point 6.6 metres northwards.  
Clearway Disabled Parking at any time
- 15 In Schedule 3B the following text is added as follows:  
5. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 2 metres north of the extended common boundary of Nos. 87 & 89 Great Cambridge Road to a point 6.6 metres southwards.  
Parking at any time Disabled Persons' Vehicles Only
- 16 In Schedule 3B the following text is added as follows:  
6. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 82 metres north of the northern kerbline of White Hart Lane to a point 5 metres northwards.  
Clearway Disabled Parking at any time
- 17 In Schedule 3B the following text is added as follows:  
7. A10 (GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD), the west side from a point 3 metres south of the extended common boundary of Nos. 107 & 109 Great Cambridge Road to a point 6.6 metres northwards.  
Parking at any time Disabled Persons' Vehicles Only
