THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (HARINGEY) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 VARIATION ORDER 2011

Made 14th September 2011

Coming into force 24th September 2011

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 Variation Order 2011, and shall come into force on 24th September 2011.

2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007^b is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 In Schedule 3A item 18 is substituted as follows: 18. A503 (SEVEN SISTERS ROAD), the north-west side from the extended common boundary of Nos. 367 and 369 Seven Sisters Road to a point 2 metres south-west of the extended common boundary of Nos. 353 and 355 Seven Sisters Road.
No Stopping Mon-Sat 7am - 7pm Except 10am-4pm loading max 20 mins and disabled persons' vehicles max 3 hours
- 2 In Schedule 3A item 19 is substituted as follows: 19. A503 (SEVEN SISTERS ROAD), the north-west side from a point 2 metres north-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 511 and 513 Seven Sisters Road to a point 5 metres south-west of the extended common boundary of Nos. 493 and 495 Seven Sisters Road.
No Stopping Mon-Sat 7am - 7pm Except 10am-4pm loading max 20 mins and disabled persons' vehicles max 3 hours

- 3 In Schedule 3A item 5 is substituted as follows: 5. A10 (BRUCE GROVE), the north-east side from a point 3 metres south-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 89 to 90 Bruce Grove and Nos. 91 to 92 Bruce Grove to a point 1 metre south-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 95 to 96 Bruce Grove and Nos. 97 to 98 Bruce Grove.
No Stopping Mon-Sat 7am - 7pm Except 10am-7pm loading max 20 mins and disabled persons' vehicles max 3 hours
- 4 In Schedule 3A the following text is added after item 20 as follows:
22. A10 (HIGH ROAD), the west side from a point 2 metres south of the extended common boundary of Nos. 451 to 453 High Road and No. 449 High Road to a point 2 metres south of the extended southern building line of No. 441 High Road.
No Stopping on Any Day 7am - 7pm Except 10am-4pm loading max 20 mins and disabled persons' vehicles max 3 hours
- 5 In Schedule 3B item 6. is deleted.
