Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 A503 Seven Sisters Road Variation Order (No.2) 2018, and shall come into force on 19th November 2018.

2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007^b is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

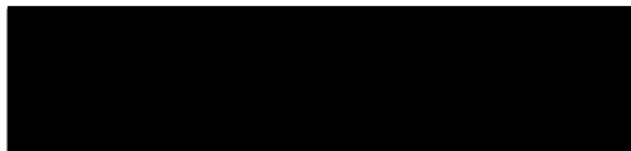
- 1 In Schedule 3A main road item 21 is added as follow:
21. A503 (SEVEN SISTERS ROAD), the south-east side from a point 1 metre south-west of the south-western building line of No. 714 Seven Sisters Road to a point 16.5 metres in south westerly direction.
No Stopping Mon-Sat 7am-7pm except 10am - 4pm loading max 20 mins and disabled persons' vehicle max 3 hours.
- 2 In Schedule 4 main road item 136 is added as follow:
136. A503 (SEVEN SISTERS ROAD), the south-east side from a point 1 metre south-west of the south-western building line of No.714 Seven Sisters Road to a point 3 metres north-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 714 and 716 Seven Sisters Road.
No Stopping At Any Time.

- 3 In Schedule 4 main road item 126 is substituted as follow:
126. A503 (SEVEN SISTERS ROAD), the south-east side from a point 17.5 metres south-west of the south western building line of No.714 Seven Sisters Road to a point 4 metres north-west of the extended north-western building line of No.618 (PH), Seven Sisters Road.
- No Stopping At Any Time.
