THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (HARINGEY) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A1 GLA ROAD (ARCHWAY ROAD) VARIATION ORDER 2011

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 A1 GLA Road (Archway Road) Variation Order 2011, and shall come into force on 11th July 2011.


2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Haringey) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007^b is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 In Schedule 2B item 1. is substituted as follows: 1. A1 (ARCHWAY ROAD), the north-east side from a point 3 metres south-east of the extended common boundary of No. 200 Archway Road and No. 200a (Highgate District Synagogue), Archway Road to the extended common boundary of Nos. 164 and 166 Archway Road .
