THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2008 VARIATION ORDER 2011

Coming into force

5th March 2011

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Kensington & Chelsea) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2008 Variation Order 2011, and shall come into force on 5th March 2011.

2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Kensington and Chelsea) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2008^b is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

1. In schedule 2A, Main Road Items, the following item is added after item 105 as follows:
 106. A3220, EARL'S COURT ROAD, the south west side, from a point opposite the party wall of 270 and 272 Earl's Court Road to a point 18 metres to the south east
2. In schedule 3A, Main Road Items, item 31, column 3 should read:
"Mon-Fri, 8am-7pm".
3. In schedule 3B, Main Road Items, item 13 should read:
13. A3220 EARL'S COURT ROAD, the south-west side from the extended common boundary of Nos. 266 and 268 Earl's Court Road to a point 15 metres to the south-east
