Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Royal Borough Of Kensington and Chelsea) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2008 A3220 GLA Road (Holland Road) Variation Order 2016, and shall come into force on 23 November 2016.

2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Royal Borough Of Kensington And Chelsea) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2008^b is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 In Schedule 2B Main the following Road item is added as follows:
 - 1. A3220 HOLLAND ROAD, the south-west side from a point 16 metres north-west of the extended south-eastern building line of Nos. 368 to 378 Kensington High Street for a distance of 15 metres in a north-westerly direction.

No Stopping At Any Time Except buses max stay 1 hour No return within 2 hours

2 In Schedule 2E Main Road item 1, is deleted.
