Coming into force 16th October 2019

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Kensington and Chelsea) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2008 A4 GLA Road (Brompton Road) Variation Order 2019, and shall come into force on 16th October 2019

2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2008^b is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 In Schedule 2D the following text is added after main road item 6:
 - 7. A4 (BROMPTON ROAD), the south-east side from a point 29 metres south-west of a point opposite the extended common boundary of Nos. 78 to 94 Prince's Court and Nos. 96 to 104 Brompton Road for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
 - No Stopping At Any Time Except Taxi Cabs at authorised times
