Coming into force 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

### 1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Kensington And Chelsea) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2008 A4 GLA Road (Brompton Road) Variation Order 2020 and shall come into force on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020.

### 2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2008<sup>b</sup> is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

1	In Schedule 3B item 30. is substituted as follows: 30. A4 (BROMPTON ROAD), the southeast side from a point 4 metres north-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 33 and 35 Brompton Road for a distance of 25 metres in a south-westerly direction. No Stopping at Any Time. Except 10am-4pm loading max 20 mins
