THE A205 AND A315 GLA ROAD (KEW BRIDGE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF HOUNSLOW) PRESCRIBED ROUTE TRAFFIC ORDER 2021

Made 1st July 2021

Coming into force 8th July 2021

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The A205 and A315 GLA Road (Kew Bridge Road, London Borough of Hounslow) Prescribed Route Traffic Order 2021, and shall come into force on 8th July 2021.

2. Prescribed Movements

- (1) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding south-westwards on lane 1 and lane 2 on the A205 GLA Road Kew Bridge Road shall cause or permit that vehicle, to proceed in any direction other than left at its junction with the A205 Kew Road;
- (2) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding north-eastwards on lane 2 and lane 3 on the A315 Kew Bridge Road shall cause or permit that vehicle, to proceed in any other direction other than right at its junction with the A205 Kew Road.

3. Exemptions

- (1) Nothing in article 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

4. Revocation of existing Order

The Hounslow (Prescribed Routes) (No.4) Traffic Order 1975^a is hereby revoked insofar as it relates items 2.(1) and 2.(2) above.
