## **THE A205 AND A315 GLA ROAD (KEW BRIDGE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF HOUNSLOW) PRESCRIBED ROUTE TRAFFIC ORDER 2021**

*Coming into force*

*8<sup>th</sup> July 2021*

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

### **1. Commencement and citation**

This Order may be cited as The A205 and A315 GLA Road (Kew Bridge Road, London Borough of Hounslow) Prescribed Route Traffic Order 2021, and shall come into force on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

### **2. Prescribed Movements**

- (1) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding south-westwards on lane 1 and lane 2 on the A205 GLA Road Kew Bridge Road shall cause or permit that vehicle, to proceed in any direction other than left at its junction with the A205 Kew Road;
- (2) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding north-eastwards on lane 2 and lane 3 on the A315 Kew Bridge Road shall cause or permit that vehicle, to proceed in any other direction other than right at its junction with the A205 Kew Road.

### **3. Exemptions**

- (1) Nothing in article 2 above shall apply to:-
  - (a) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

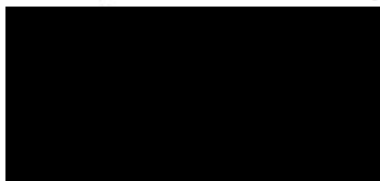
