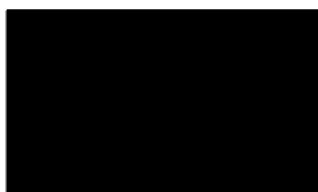
Coming into force

1st February 2016

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as The A30 GLA Road (Great South-West Road, Hounslow) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2016 and shall come into force on the 1st February 2016.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. The Trunk Roads (50 m.p.h Speed Limit) (England) Order 1965^b is hereby revoked, in so far as any of its provisions relate to any lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
