THE A312 GLA ROAD (CHURCH ROAD SERVICE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF EALING) PRESCRIBED ROUTE TRAFFIC ORDER 2015

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The A312 GLA Road (Church Road Service Road, London Borough of Ealing) Prescribed Route Traffic Order 2015, and shall come into force on 15th June 2015.

2. Prescribed Movement

- (a) No person causing or permitting a vehicle proceeding north-eastwards on A312 GLA Road Church Road shall cause or permit that vehicle to enter the Service Road fronting Nos.470 to 500 A312 Church Road other than via the access opposite No.500 and to proceed in any direction other than north-eastwards and exit the Service Road via the access opposite No.472.

3. Exemptions

- (1) Nothing in article 2 above shall apply to:-
- (a) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
