## **THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (HOUNSLOW) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A4 GLA SIDE ROAD (PARKLANDS PARADE) VARIATION ORDER 2010**

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

### **1. Commencement and citation**

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Hounslow) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 A4 GLA Side Road (Parklands Parade) Variation Order 2010, and shall come into force on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2010.

### **2. Variations**

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Hounslow) Red Route Consolidation Traffic Order 2007<sup>b</sup> is varied by the following provisions of this Order.

- 1 In Schedule 2B item 8. (in the vicinity of the A4) is substituted as follows: 8. (in the vicinity of the A4) PARKLANDS PARADE, the north-east side from a point 4 metres south-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 3 and 4 Parklands Parade to a point 3 metres north-west of the extended common boundary of Nos. 1 and 2 Parklands Parade.  
Parking Mon-Sat 7am - 7pm 1 hour No return within 2 hours
- 2 Schedule 2B the following text is added after item 16 as follows:  
17. (in the vicinity of the A4) PARKLANDS PARADE, the north-east side from a point 1 metre north-west of the extended south-eastern building line on No.8 Parklands Parade to a point 2.4 metres south-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 5 and 6 Parklands Parade.  
Parking Mon-Sat 7am - 7pm 1 hour No return within 2 hours

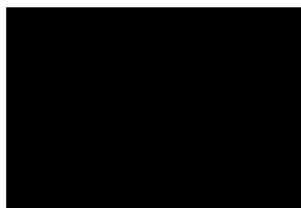

- 3 In Schedule 2C item 1. (in the vicinity of the A4) is deleted.
- 4 In Schedule 3A item 1. (in the vicinity of the A4) is deleted.
- 5 In Schedule 3A item 2. (in the vicinity of the A4) is substituted as follows: 2.  
(in the vicinity of the A4) PARKLANDS PARADE, the north-east side from a  
point 0.5 metres south-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 5 and  
6 Parklands Parade to a point 4 metres south-east of the extended common  
boundary of Nos. 3 and 4 Parklands Parade.
