THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (HOUNSLOW) RED ROUTE (CLEARWAY) CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 VARIATION ORDER 2011

Transport for London in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order—

1. Commencement and citation

This Order may be cited as The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Hounslow) Red Route (Clearway) Consolidation Traffic Order 2007 Variation Order 2011, and shall come into force on 17th September 2011.

2. Variations

The GLA Roads and GLA Side Roads (Hounslow) Red Route (Clearway) Consolidation Traffic Order 2007^b is varied by the following provisions of this Order.


- 1 In Schedule 2 the following text is added after item 148 as follows:
151. A312 (THE PARKWAY), the west side northbound carriageway, from a point 325 metres south of the southern kerblines of the M4 roundabout to a point 98 metres to the north.
Red Route Clearway Borough Bays
- 2 In Schedule 2 the following text is added after item 148 as follows:
152. A312 (THE PARKWAY), the east side southbound carriageway, from a point 334 metres north of the northern kerblines of the Great West Road to a point 71 metres Southwards.
Red Route Clearway Borough Bays
- 3 In Schedule 2 the following text is added after item 148 as follows:
153. A312 (THE PARKWAY), the east side southbound carriageway, from a point 221 metres south of the southern kerblines of the M4 roundabout to a point 88 metres to the south.

- 4 In Schedule 2 the following text is added after item 148 as follows:
154. A312 (THE PARKWAY), the west side northbound carriageway, from a point 293 metres north of the northern kerbline of the Great West Road to a point 71 metres Northwards.
Red Route Clearway Borough Bays
- 5 In Schedule 3A item 4 is substituted as follows: 4. A4 (GREAT WEST ROAD), the north side from the extended south-western building line of No. 644 Great West Road for a distance of 39 metres in a south-westerly direction.
No Stopping At Any Time Except Parking 20 mins No return within 40 mins
- 6 In Schedule 4B item 1 column 2 is substituted as follows: 1. A4 (GREAT WEST ROAD), the north side from the extended common boundary of Nos. 8 and 9 York Road to a point 1 metre north-east of the extended common boundary of Nos. 6 and 7 York Parade.
