Help to sign up for membership to London Dial-a-Ride

Dial-a-Ride is Transport for London's free door-to-door service for those who cannot always use our buses, trains and trams.

On Tuesday 17 April starting at 10:00 till 13:00 help will be made available to help residents complete the form to become Dial-a-Ride members. TfL will provide a stationary bus to use as an office, and to answer any questions or concerns you have directly with the Dial-a-Ride team.

Once a group have become members, the Dial-a-Ride team will also arrange a trial return shopping journey into Kingston to give you an idea of how the service operates.

As I stated on Monday this includes running a Monday service on the present schedule as requested by residents of Riverhill and Lovelace Gardens. This would operate at the same time as the present timetable.
