4 Borough Programme Updates

Waltham Forest (MB)

- 31 October 2017 Urbo dockless cycle trial will be launched in the borough.
- Hosted the Healthy Streets Conference on 28 September launched borough wide Green Courier scheme, the borough wide 'Living Map' and also the Waltham Forest Cycle Account. Lea Bridge Road won another award in the category 'Proposal of the Year' at the Healthy Streets awards and have been shortlisted in a number of other awards including Transport Authority of the year.
- Lea Bridge Road section A is complete and Section B is 80% complete.
 Off highway work for Whipps Cross underway and working with NIMT to secure TMAN approval. MB flagged that the borough will need to submit a risk drawdown request for a drainage issue that has been unexpectedly encountered at Wood Street.
- St James Cycle Hub will launch next month and the borough are in negotiation with the developer at Blackhorse Station to install a hub on their site.

Kingston (TA)

- Kingston Station and Wheatfield Way are under construction (note that Wheatfield Way was not reported as on site on the highlight report but will be amended).
- All schemes have been consulted on except for the Riverside Boardway, and a number of schemes have now received committee approval including Kingston to Kingston Vale and Penryn Road. Some schemes that have not started on site yet will commence next financial year subject to TfL funding and approvals.

 Planning application for New Malden to Raynes Park link will be submitted in December.

- JC and TA expressed concern that schemes which are not on/no impact on the TLRN/SRN but have an impact on bus journey times should not be presented to RSPG for approval but another forum should be found.

1 Introduction

2 Wheatfield Way

UM (Atkins) gave an overview of progress to date:

- Phase 4 has been completed, everything made good for the Christmas period.

- Next phase Old Road Roundabout to Clarence Street. Materials pre-order has been issued to Kier for them to procure.

- River Link work has commenced and will continue over the Christmas period as this is off-carriageway and on Network Rail owned land.
- Relocation of the SWR cycle hub is underway, awaiting relocation of CCTV before temporary store can be opened.
- Granite materials Enough quantity for Fife Road and Wood Street, the issue is the mix of colours ("greys"). Too much mid-greys compared to "dark" greys. Currently procuring additional "dark" from Portugal, but if this does not come through we are still in a position to alter the pattern and lay in Wood Street.

MP asked about impact on traffic along Wood Street. He questioned the statement that "there has been no impact", asked for a metric to measure the current traffic situation. KJ stated that from a buses operation point of view, they have not experienced any delays due to the reduced lanes.
