Bringing you the next stage of the Elizabeth line

Lines from Reading, Heathrow, and Shenfield are now connected with the central tunnels of the Elizabeth line - opening up new direct journeys across the capital. This means that customers travelling from Reading and Heathrow are able to travel east all the way to Abbey Wood via Canary Wharf without changing at Paddington. Customers travelling from Shenfield are able to travel west all the way to Paddington without changing at Liverpool Street. Customers who need to change Elizabeth line trains, for onward destinations towards Reading, Heathrow, Abbey Wood or Shenfield should change at Whitechapel.

Increased operating hours and Sunday services will see the Elizabeth line run seven days a week.

All 41 stations on the Elizabeth line have lifts providing step-free access to platforms.

Step-free access from platform to street

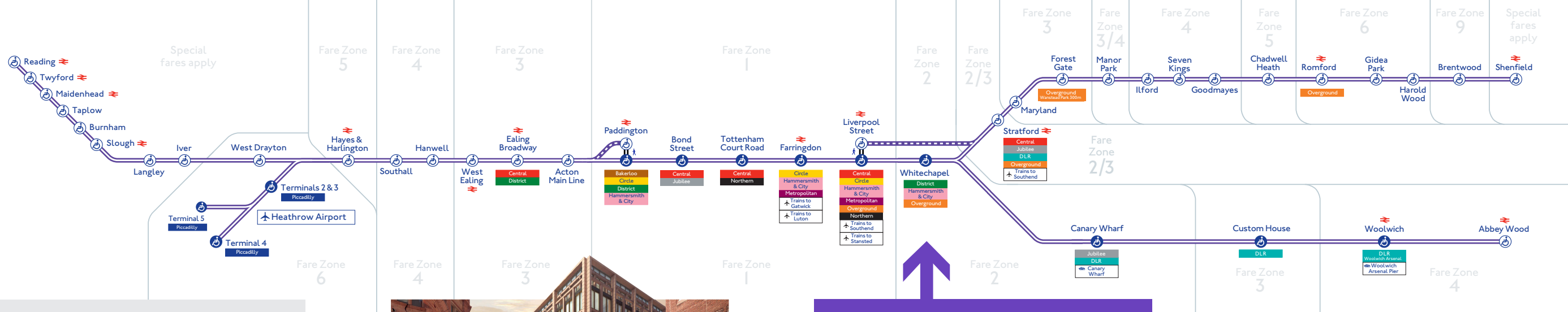

Paddington

Some early, late and weekend services to/from Heathrow and Reading depart or terminate at National Rail platforms. Please check before you travel.

Trains will wait for up to 7 minutes

Some trains are scheduled to wait for up to 7 minutes approaching Paddington towards Abbey Wood. This is temporary and will come to an end in May 2023.



Bond Street

Bond Street Elizabeth line station is now open. The step-free station provides a new link to one of the busiest shopping districts in the UK and should relieve congestion at the nearby Oxford Circus station. It features two brand new ticket halls at street level and improvements to the urban realm surrounding the station.

If you need to change for onward Elizabeth line destinations, please change at Whitechapel.

Travelling with a buggy

Some stations have short platforms, please travel in the correct carriage.

Customers with buggies should travel in first 4 carriages.
