1996/797 part 0 - Railway vehicle; LER 1927- Standard tube stock driving motor car No 3327, 1927 was transferred to the Science Museum in South Kensington in 1961 after it was withdrawn from service. It was displayed from 1967 in the Rail Transport Gallery at the Science Museum. The vehicle was transferred to London Transport Museum and added to the permanent collection in 1996.

1991/18 part 0 - Railway vehicle; City & South London Railway electric locomotive no 13, built by Mather & Platt, 1890 was transferred to the Science Museum in 1924 after it was withdrawn from service. It came to London Transport Museum as a loan in 1990 for the Tube Centenary exhibition. The title of ownership of the locomotive was transferred from the Science Museum Group to London Transport Museum and the vehicle became part of LTM's permanent collection in August 2022. The vehicle itself is an electric locomotive, and therefore, not a passenger car. Additionally, it is City & South London Railway (C&SLR), not strictly an LT/LUL vehicle, since these companies didn't exist at the time.
