It's the Excel between 18th – 20th, we are located at Booth IF1340 – please let me know if you would like to schedule a meeting there.

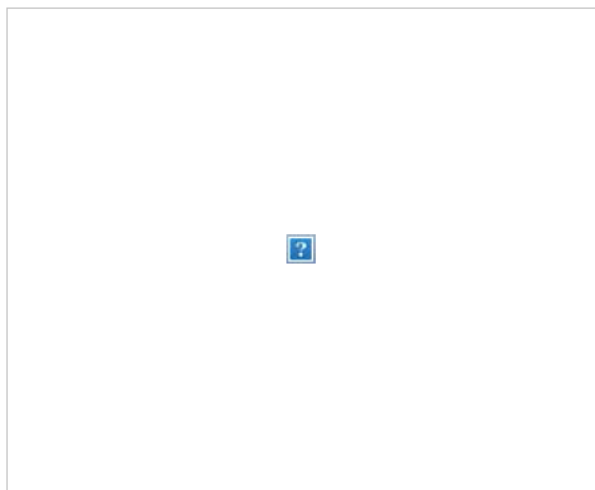
