

WHY YOU MUST WEAR A FACE COVERING ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

MAYOR OF LONDON

In line with government guidelines, you must wear a face covering at all times on all TfL and National Rail services. Face coverings are there to protect those around you and they also protect you. If you do not, you could be refused travel or face a £200 fine which doubles with every violation up to £6,400.

Please be considerate of other passengers. Not all disability is visible and exemptions to the use of face coverings do apply for age, health and disability reasons and for children under 11.

Make sure your face covering shields both your nose and mouth at all times. They are not a replacement for social distancing and regular hand washing.

WHY YOU MUST WEAR A FACE COVERING ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

MAYOR OF LONDON

In line with government guidelines, you must wear a face covering at all times on all TfL and National Rail services. If you do not you may be turned away from the network and could be fined. This includes buses, Tube, TfL Rail, DLR, London Overground, Trams, Dial-a-Ride, river services and the Emirates Air Line. Make sure your face covering shields both your mouth and nose.

Please be considerate of other passengers. Not all disability is visible and exemptions to the use of face coverings do apply for age, health and disability reasons and for children under 11.

Face coverings are not a replacement for social distancing and regular hand washing.
